

ADOLESCENT VACCINATION

This resource includes information that may be useful in identifying appropriate patients and creating patient lists (registries) using your electronic health records (EHR) system. Identifying appropriate preteens and adolescents for vaccination can be approached in different ways; some suggestions may be more relevant for your practice than others. Building a system that efficiently utilizes time, personnel, and resources can make identification and communication with appropriate patients a more seamless part of your daily workflow. Regarding the suggestions provided here, keep in mind that laws and regulations related to sending communications by e-mail or phone vary by state. Using Your EHR to Identify Select Groups of Preen and Adolescent Patients

Relevant information that can be used to identify appropriate preteen and adolescent patients for vaccination

- Age 11 or older
- Have received a meningococcal and/or Tdap vaccination
- Have not scheduled an appointment in 12 months



Identifying select groups of appropriate adolescent patients may help you:

- Set reminders
- Generate patient lists and do patient outreach (eg, hard copy, Web site, patient portal)
- Develop order sets with therapies, patient education, and future reminders



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
