You can help protect your children from at least 18 vaccine-preventable diseases.

VFC Program

The Vaccines for Children (VFC) Program offers free vaccines to qualified children if they are age 18 years or younger and one of the following:

- Uninsured
- Medicaid-eligible
- Underinsured
- American Indian or Alaska Native

Talk to your child's doctor to see if your child qualifies.

There are over 37,000 providers nationwide

(Parents, guardians, or other caregivers responsible for the child must choose a provider in their state)

Most pediatricians are part of the Vaccines for Children Program.

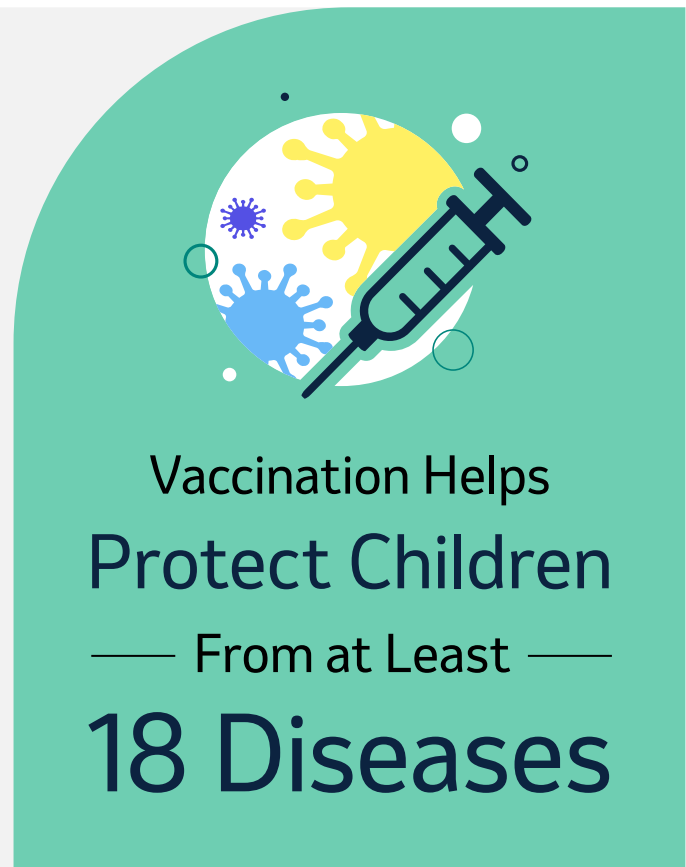
