Origination

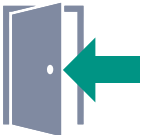


Consider

- Assessing your upcoming visit schedule to determine inventory needs.

Consider

- Any recent changes to your patient flow.
- How you are currently managing patient flow for your different populations of patients.
- How you are managing your inventory to support that flow.

- How ordering vaccines for back to school may change based on your current patient flow.
- How the upcoming flu season may impact your ordering of vaccines.
